### **Ben Davies**

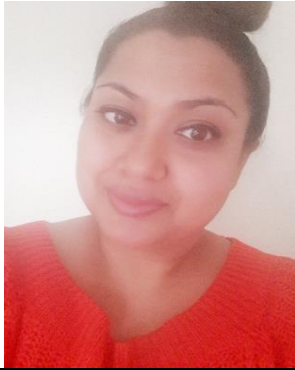
